Don't forget to tempt your child with interesting, miscellaneous items. Simply leave items for your student in a familiar place. Allow him to find, examine, and explore!

- 1. tub of pattern blocks
- 2. magnifying glass, binoculars, or pocket microscope
- 3. <u>new game</u>
- 4. blank notebook and fancy-fun pen
- 5. box of recyclables (cartons, lids, boxes) for imaginative/inventive play
- 6. magazine left open to an article that might grab your child's attention
- 7. watercolor pencils & watercolor paper (or other new art supplies)
- 8. geoboard with rubber bands
- 9. comic strip templates
- 10. puzzle book (crossword, Sudoku, etc.)
- 11. box of building materials
- 12. cook book (make sure the book is open to a yummy recipe!)
- 13. tape measure, ruler, measuring cups/spoons, kitchen scale, etc.
- 14. letter written in "secret code" ~ provide code so student can decode the letter & he might just write you back!
- 15. <u>Bare Book</u> or a <u>Bare Gameboard</u>
- 16. calculator
- 17. box of craft supplies
- 18. disposable camera
- 19. letter tiles (from Scrabble, Banangrams, or Upwords)
