Indiana History Class Syllabus











Course description: We will be studying the history, symbols and interesting facts about our state with many field trip opportunities. Each student will be making a notebook throughout the course of the study.

Target age: Grades 4th-6th (recommended for 4th graders by Indiana State standards)

Course outline:

Week 1 (Aug.29): Map activities, state symbols and Mounds builders

Field trip (Fri, Sept. 2): Mounds State Park, 4306 Mounds Road, Anderson, Indiana

There are 10 mounds built by the Adena-Hopewell people

Gate fee: \$5 per car, \$1 per student program fee

Tour time: 10:30am - noon, bring a sack lunch optional

Week 2 (Sept. 12): Early Explorers and Early battles

Field trip (Tues, Sept. 13): Levi Coffin House (stop on the Underground Railroad)

Week 3 (Sept. 19): More battles and the Civil War and the Underground Railroad

Week 4 (Oct. 3): Pioneer Life
