

# Spanish for Fun!



**Description:** The student will learn a very basic understanding of the Spanish language through hands-on games, songs, and writing. It is best if the student can write on his or her own with minimal assistance.

**Target Age:** K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade

<b>Week 1</b>	Basic understanding of how different languages came about, referencing Genesis chapter 11. Take-home books will be made of Spanish-speaking countries.
<b>Week 2</b>	Making a Spanish dictionary to fill in throughout the semester; learn how to greet one another in Spanish.
<b>Week 3</b>	<b>Los Colores!</b> We'll be learning all of the colors of the rainbow!
<b>Week 4</b>	<b>Mi Cuerpo!</b> We'll be learning all the parts of our body and tracing our bodies on butcher paper to label and take home. We'll also learn the Spanish translation of head, shoulders, knees and toes!
<b>Week 5</b>	<b>Puedo Contar!</b> We'll be learning how to count to 20 in Spanish.
<b>Week 6</b>	<b>Vamos a tildar la habitacion!</b> Let's label the room! We'll be learning the parts of a room and making labels for the child to take home and put up at home in his or her own room!
<b>Week 7</b>	<b>Palabras de accion!</b> We'll be learning songs to help us remember some basic action words in Spanish.
<b>Week 8</b>	<b>Dias de la semana y meses del ano!</b> We'll be learning the days of the week and months of the year in Spanish and how to write the child's birth date.
<b>Week 9</b>	<b>El Tiempo y estacion!</b> We'll be learning the seasons of the year and weather related words in Spanish. A take-home book will be made.
<b>Week 10</b>	<b>Los animales!</b> We'll learn the names of some of your favorite animals.
<b>Week 11</b>	<b>Alimentos que yo como!</b> We'll learn the names of some of your favorite fruits and vegetables in Spanish.
<b>Week 12</b>	<b>Vamos a cocinar!</b> Let's cook some yummy Spanish-style desserts to celebrate our last class together!
<b>Cost:</b>	The cost of this class will be \$8.00 per student to cover take-home books, dictionaries, and food.
