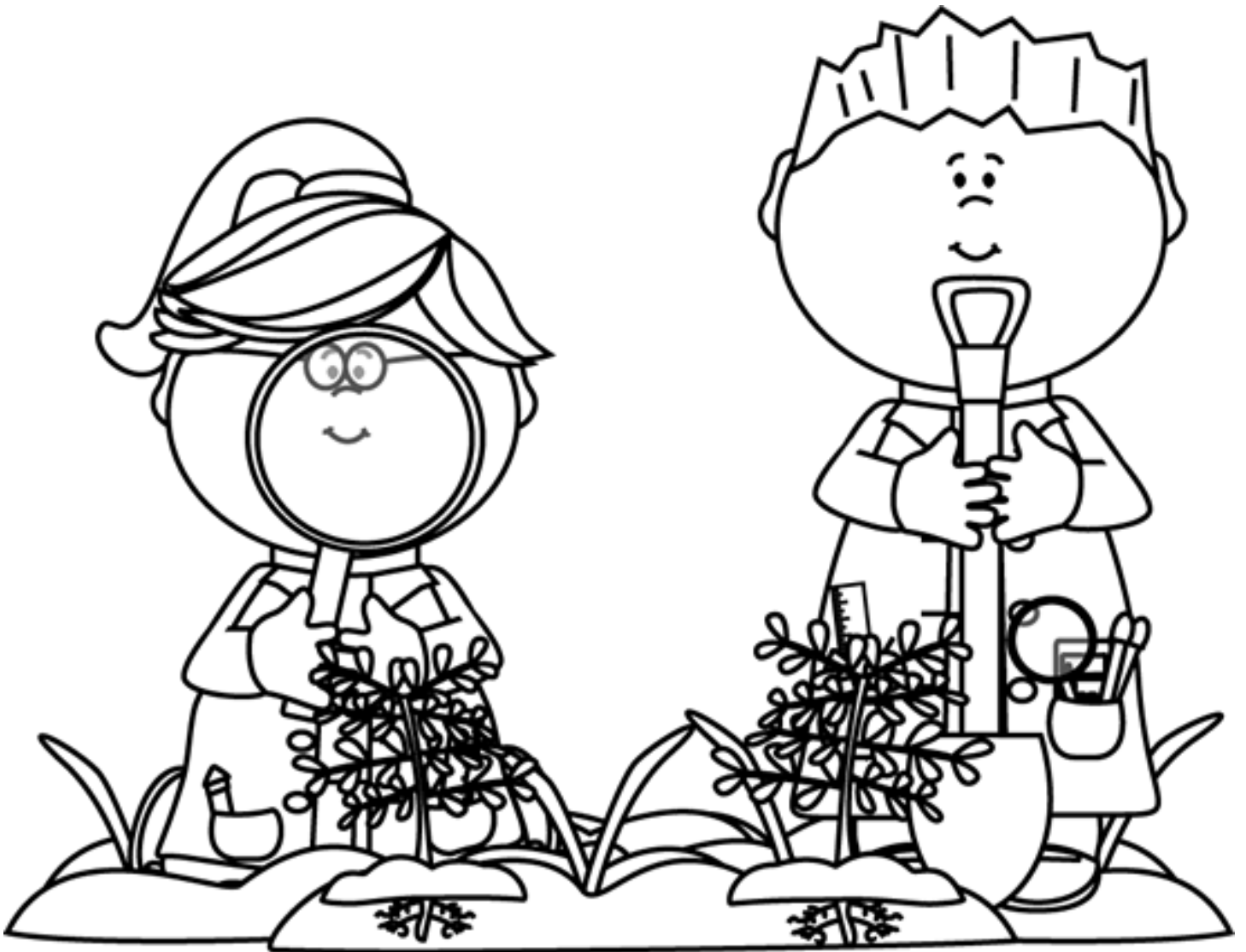

Ideas and Prompts for Journal Pages

1. Use the pages for students to write summaries of what they learn in class:
 - How does a seed grow?
 - What are the parts of a flower?
 - What do plants need?
 - Make a list of tools needed in the garden.
2. Read nonfiction books and use the pages to record facts about plants and gardening.
3. You could also use the pages for a variety of creative writing activities.
 - What would you plant in your garden? (real and imaginary!)
 - What animals did you find in your garden? (real and imaginary!)
 - Write about a giant vegetable or fruit you found in your garden.
