Page 2 – Book 6 Cut, Paste, and Read

Discuss question marks with your student. Discuss how your voice changes when you ask a question. Practice asking the questions found in the reader. After your discussion, cut out the question marks on the page. Glue one question mark to the end of each sentence. Let your student practice reading the sentences.

Page 3 – In the Bag Game

Cut out word cards. Put them in a brown paper bag. Ask your student to pull the cards out one at a time and read them. After reading the cards, find the cards with the hotdogs. Ask your student to sort them (one pile for -ag rhymes and one pile for -ot rhymes).

Page 4 – Roll and Read Game




Page 5 – Book 6 Words to Type
