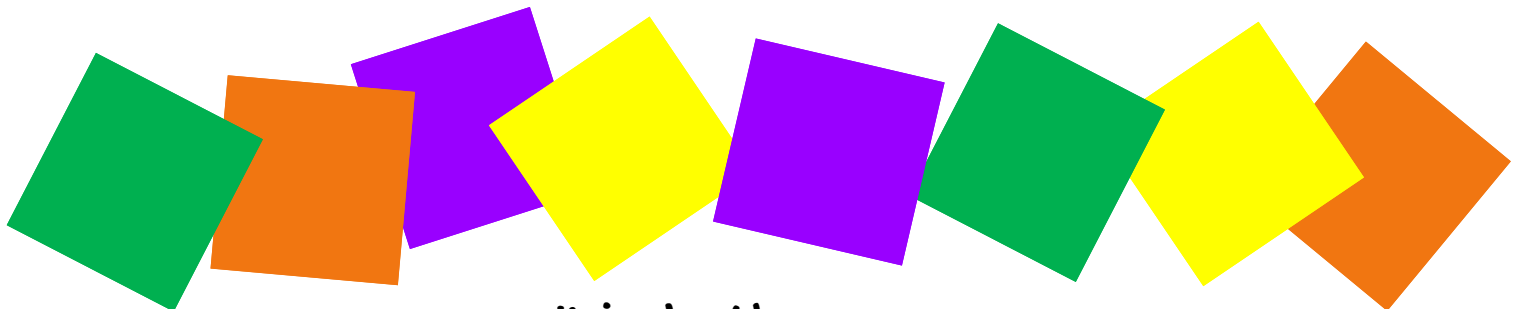

paint chip sudoku

1. Choose four large paint chips for each board. Each paint chip should be a different color.
2. Cut paint chips into fourths, so you have 16 pieces for each board.
3. Print the game boards.
4. Glue pieces on to the numbered areas of the boards, using one number to represent each color.
5. Store the game board and the rest of the pieces in a storage bag.

Teach your student how to play Sudoku. There should be one and only one of each color in each row and column. Enjoy!
