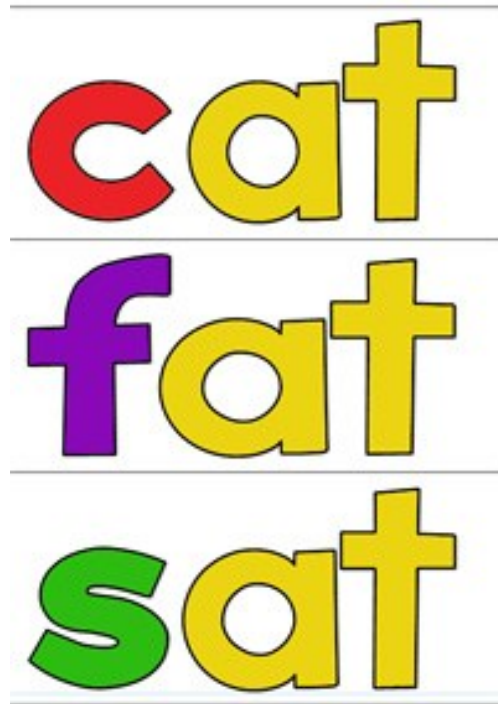


Words to Color

Help your student learn to read more easily with these Words to Color. Choose any color for the first letter in each word. Choose another color for the ending for each word family. For example, color all the a's and t's in the -at words yellow.



Use the word cards to practice reading in lots of different ways!

You can add the bonus words to make sentences.

You can have your student sort them into rhyming groups and then read the words.

You can hide them in the house and have your student find them and read them.

You can have your student hide them from you. When you find them, your student has to read them.

You can play memory match using two cards from each word family. You win a pair every time you find a pair of rhyming words.
